Jacqueline Saper

Jacqueline was born in Tehran, Iran. As the daughter of a university professor, she was raised in a Jewish family in the affluent north shore district of Tehran. With the onset of the uprising, she lived through the chaos and the civil unrest of the 1979 revolution. Unlike most Iranian Jews who left Iran during that time, Jacqueline and her family remained in Iran for eight more years after Ayatollah Khomeini took power from the pro-Western monarch, Mohammad Reza Pahlavi, known as the 'Shah'.

Once she eventually immigrated to the United States with her husband and two young children, Ms. Saper had the opportunity to pursue an education and became a Certified Public Accountant. She has since spent most of her career in synagogue management and Jewish education. Jacqueline is a graduate of the 'Hadassah Leadership Academy' and the 'Florence Melton School (Morasha) for educators. She has also served as an adjunct faculty member at Oakton Community College.

In 2009, her career path took a new direction as a translator and interpreter for private law firms and organizations such as the National Immigrant Justice Center, to help with the influx of refugees following the disputed presidential elections in Iran. Most recently Jacqueline has completed her collaboration with Left Brain/Right Brain Productions, in the translation and subtitling of the feature movie, "Alex & Ali".
